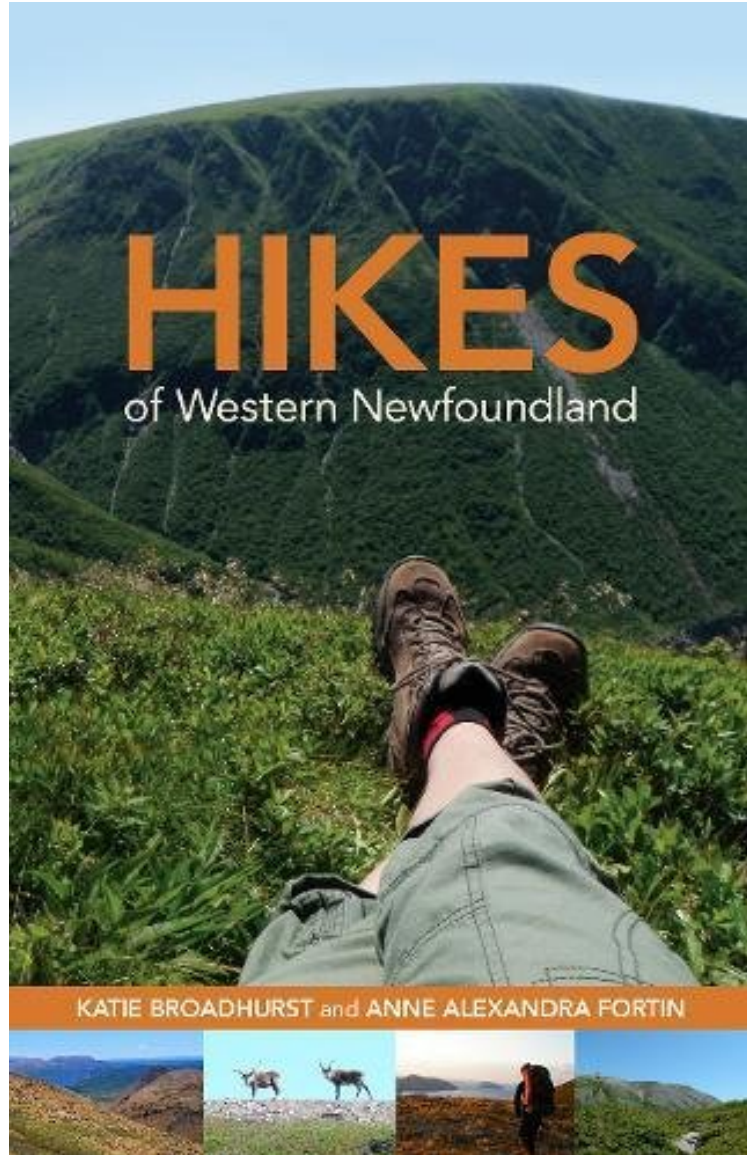

There's not a lot of detail on each hike, but all the trails were so clearly marked that a lot of detail isn't needed. One mild warning -- the Gros Morne trail map was a bit impressionistic. It is a path with a loop, but the actual path and loop are different relative sizes than is shown on the map.
