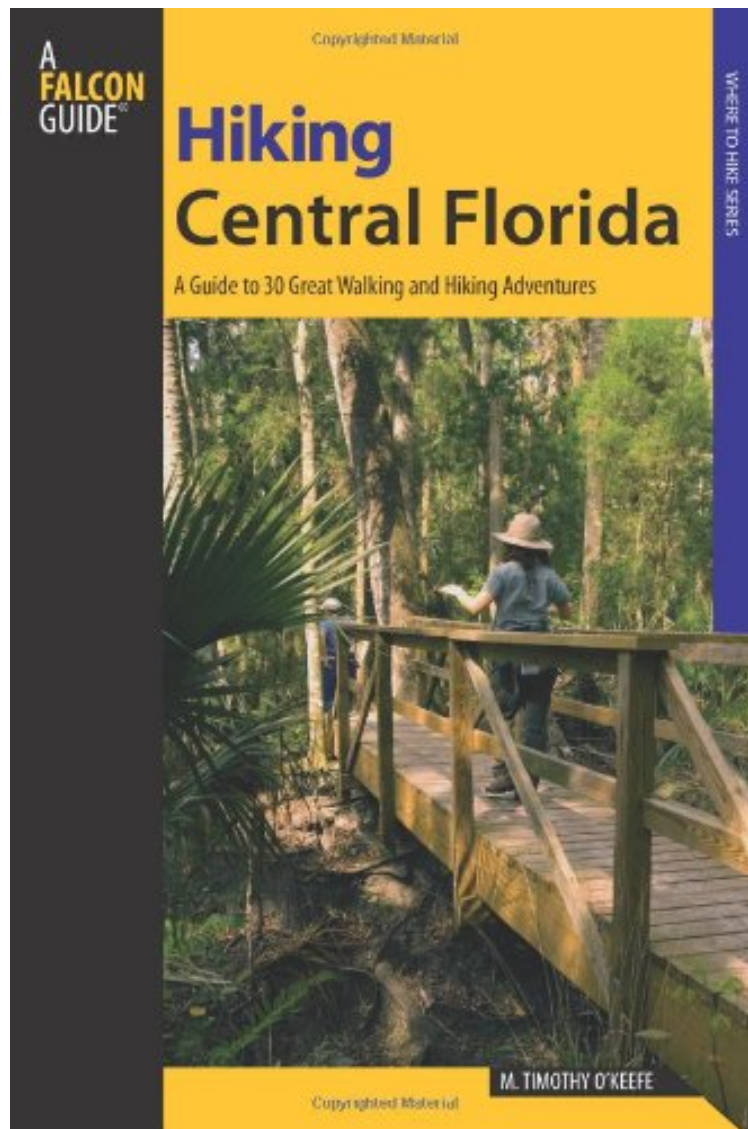

There are so many trails near my home in North Brevard County, and I ordered this book so I could learn more about them. I live near the Merritt Island Wildlife Refuge, which has about five trails. I was hoping for them all to be described, but only one was. There are lots of other trails that are further away, which I am very glad to know about, but it's not exactly what I was looking for. I appreciate how the trails are grouped into different categories based on length, and how the author provides recommendations for where to go. However, on loop trails it's not immediately obvious which direction you are supposed to walk the trail. There is a map for each trail, and it would be nice to have numbers on the map corresponding to the directions. One thing I'm really excited about is exploring the Disney Wildlife Preserve. You'd never think something with the Disney name would be a nature adventure, and I wouldn't have known about it if not for this book.
