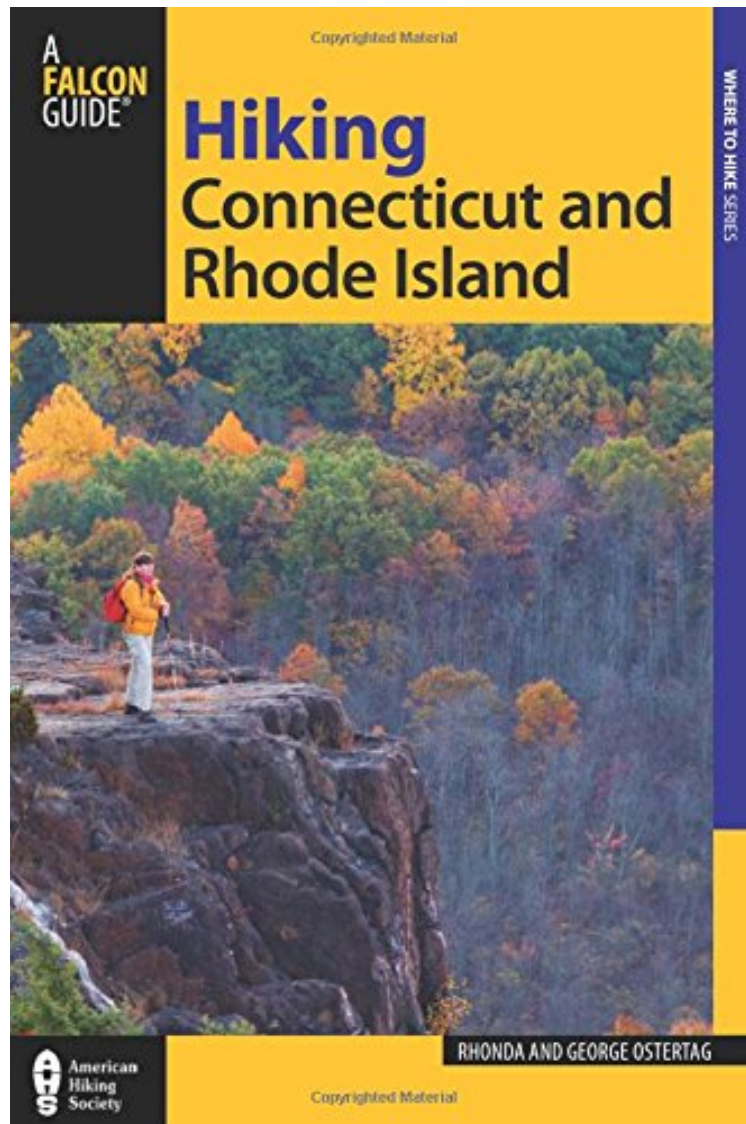

I already owned the Ostertags' 2002 book "Hiking

Southern New England" and this appears to be the successor to that book. Be advised that the newer book has a heavy Connecticut focus with two-thirds of the book dedicated to the Nutmeg State, so if you want Rhode Island hikes, the options for the Ocean State are somewhat limited. The book is well organized with all the needed information about where to hike, including the difficulty rating, directions to the trailhead, clear narratives, easy-to-read maps, and beautiful photographs. The areas they discuss are among my favorite places to hike. As with any hiking book, I recommend checking directly with the organization that owns the property to see if there are any trail changes since the book you are using has been published. I also recommend downloading a trail map from that organization, as those maps will have all the trails in an area, whereas this book shows mostly the trails related to the hikes as they are discussed. After this book went to press, Connecticut changed from the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) to the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP), changing its web links along the way.
