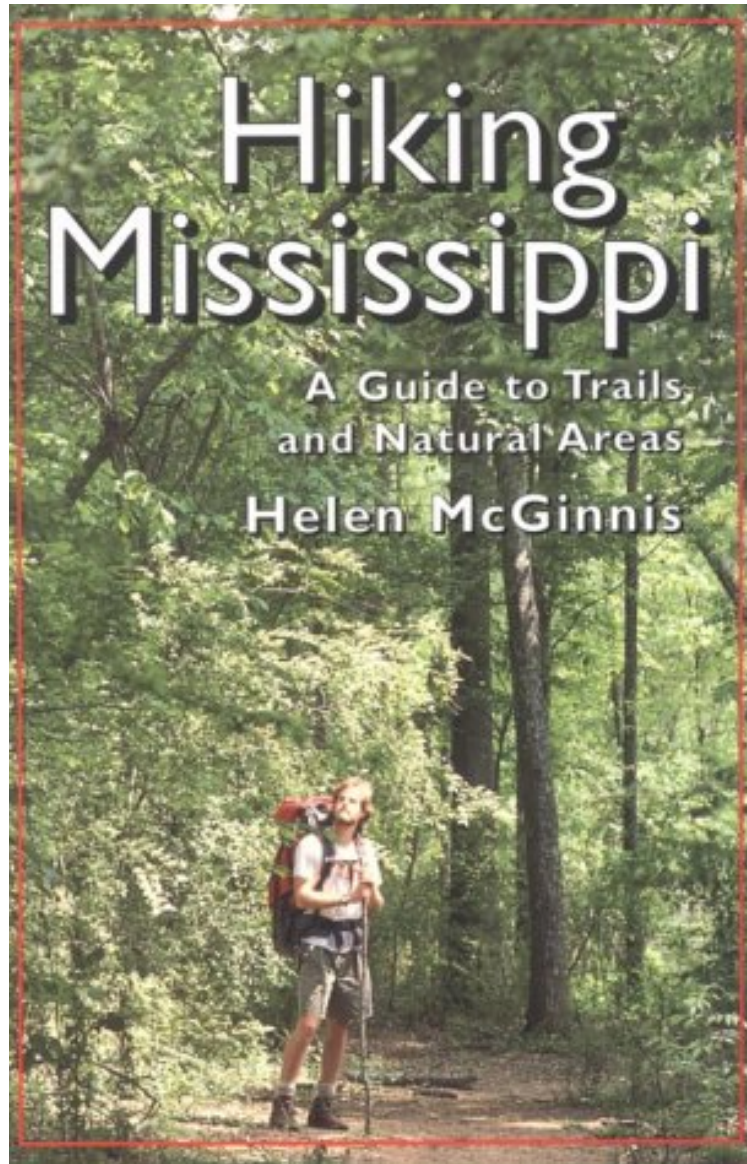

Unfortunately, the author is misleading: Mississippi, though a beautiful state with many national forests and refuges, is not an outdoors paradise, unless you happen to be a fisherman or a hunter. As a fairly experienced hiker, I was excited to use this book to explore my new surroundings. However, much to my disappointment, I found this book to be difficult to use, lacking basic information such as directions to the trail heads, elevation gain, and maps of the actual hikes. Instead, the author provides a series of topographical maps and detailed maps of the overall area (forest, park, etc) which do little to give the reader a real sense of the hike.
