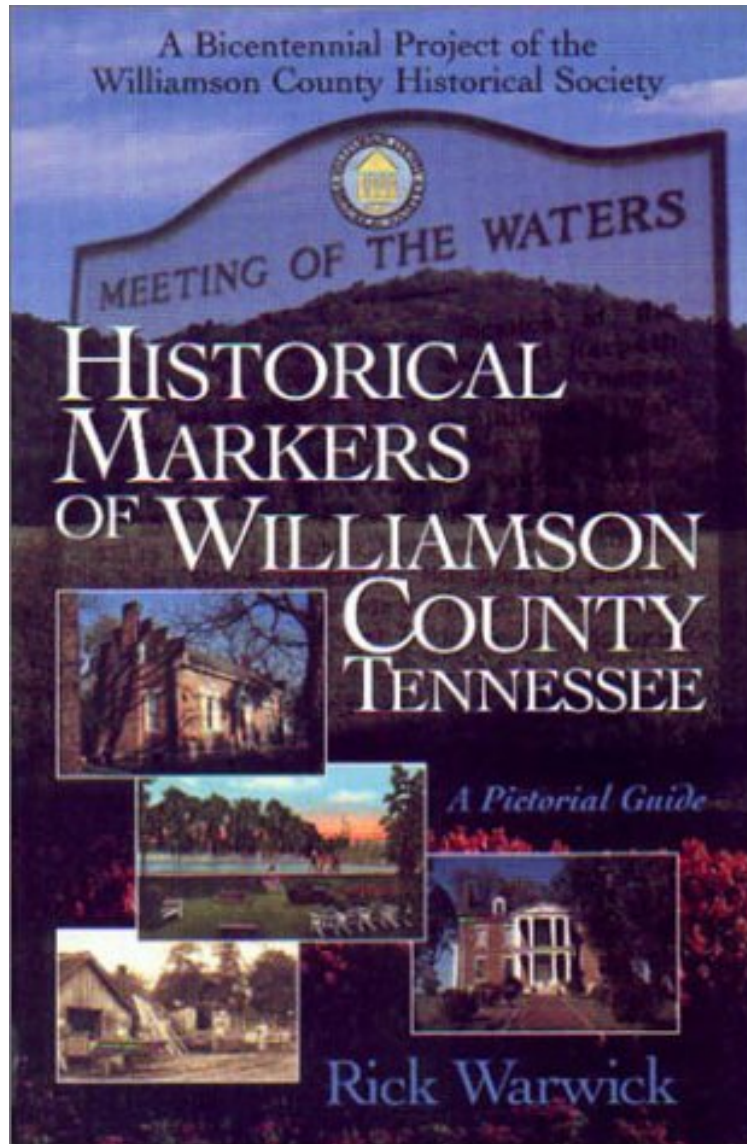

This book traces the history of beautiful Williamson County, Tennessee by means of a guidebook to its 160 historical markers--a history that encompasses the ebbs and flows of the rural South--including prehistoric Indian mounds, antebellum mansions and humble homesteads, churches once frequented by circuit riders, slave cabins, Civil War battle sites, springs with purported curative powers, and long-gone communities and businesses. Area maps make this self-guided tour easy to follow. Each entry contains complete site marker information, and the book is fully illustrated with historic photographs.
