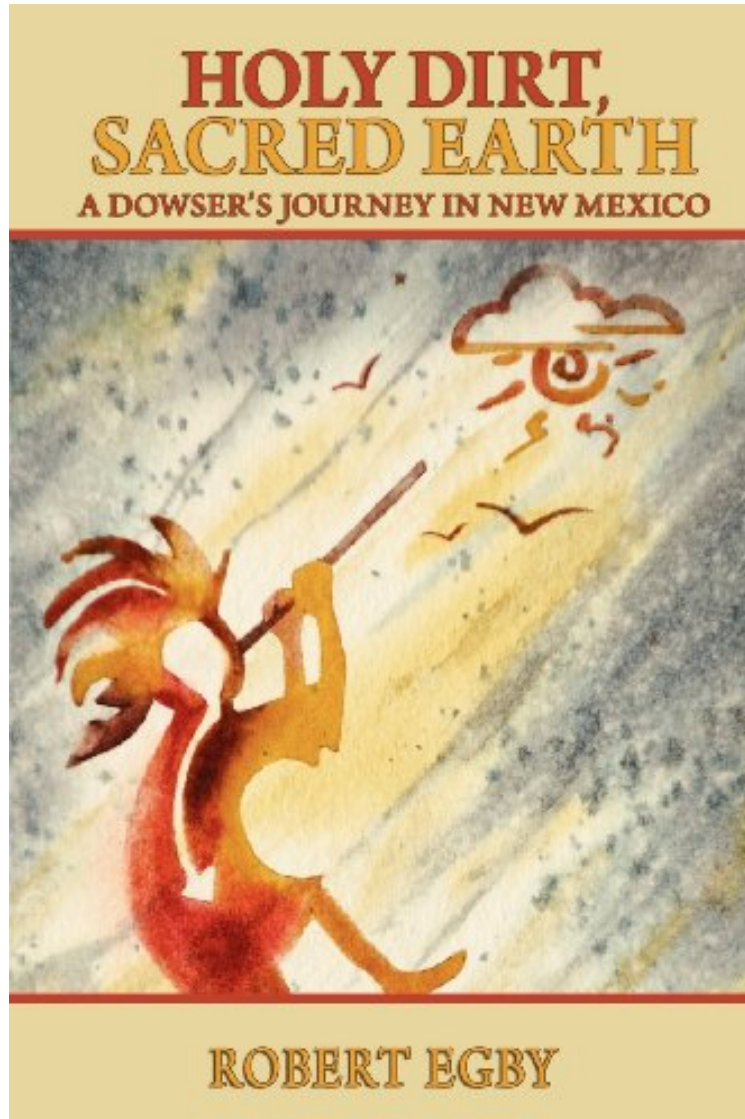

Spaeth For the most part, this is a wonderfully written book except for a lack of punctuation causing run on sentences, as well as typos. These issues may have been addressed in more recent copies of his publications, but they weren't in my copy. As a person who is interested in dowsing, I learned of Robert Egby's methods and how he applied them to finding ley lines, geospirals, vortexes (some say vortices), etc. in New Mexico. Plenty of good background information was presented, was very well researched and all meshed admirably into the historical storyline Bob was telling.
