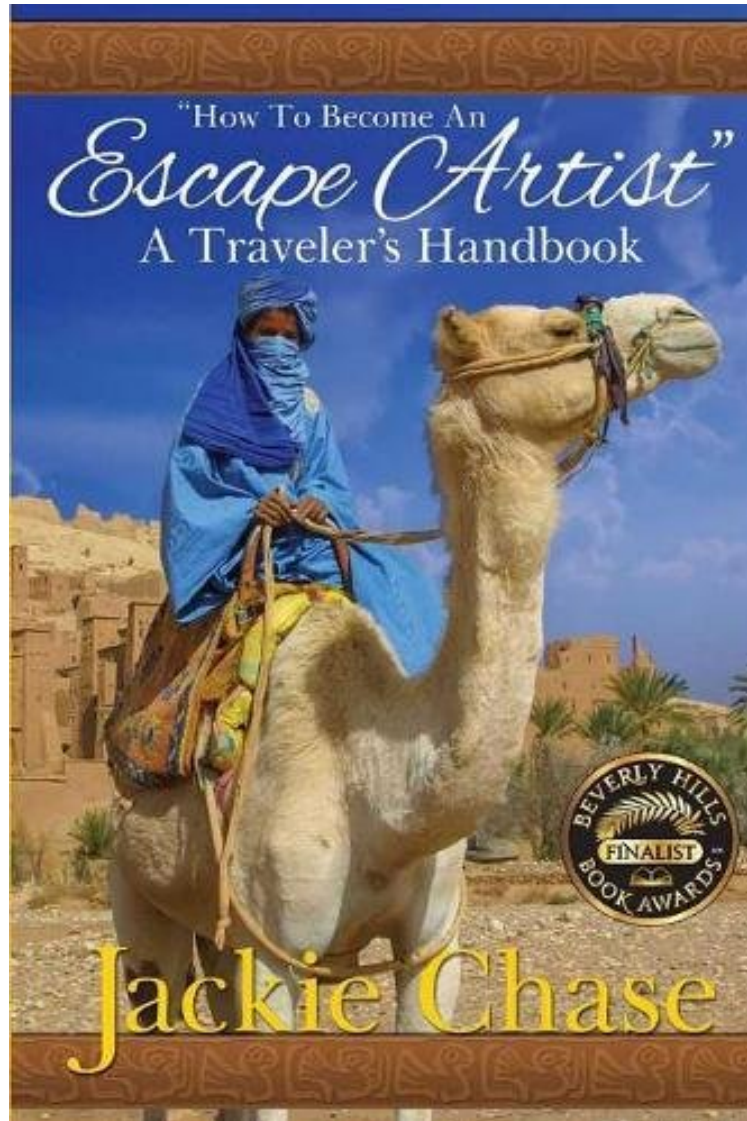

If you are the kind of person (tourist) that likes to fly into a place and stay at the same all- inclusive resort for your entire stay, then this book is not for you. However, if you are the type of traveler who likes to get off the beaten path you can learn a trick or two from Ms. Chase who has been to over 100 countries. To me the most helpful chapters were on safety (for example: how to hide your money) and the resource lists for what to bring on trips of different lengths. I typically use lonely planet guides and this book is a great addition for a new traveler or someone wanting to think through whether they are prepared for their next adventure.
