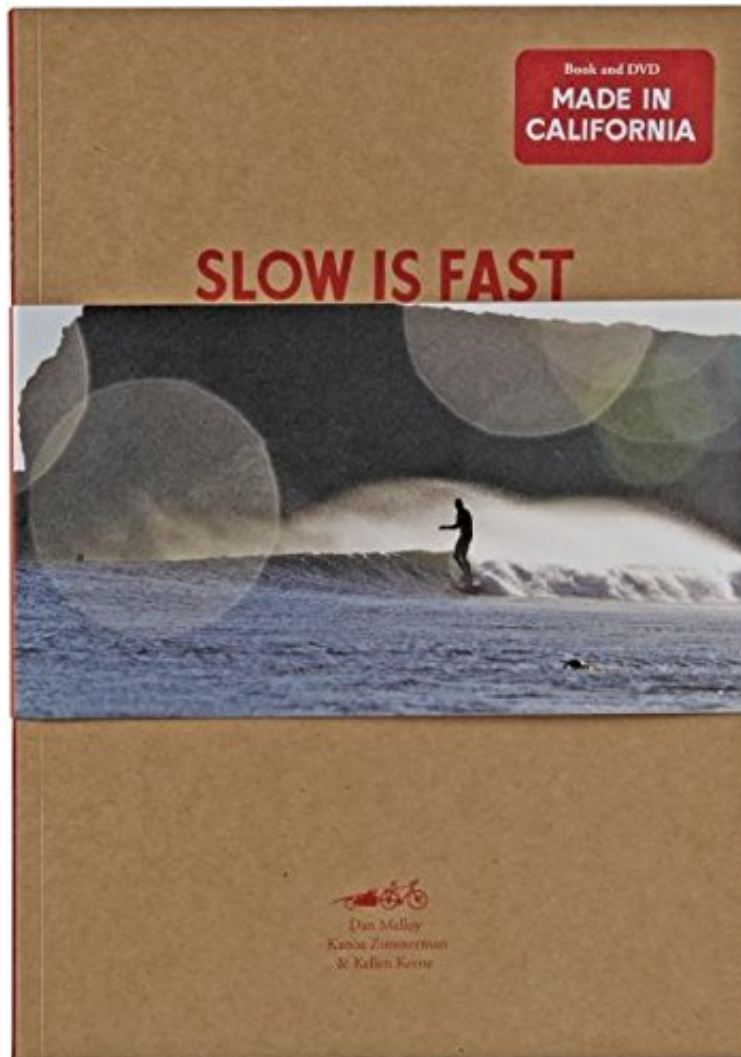

While I am a fan of the Malloy brothers in general--they have made some epic surf films and 180 South is one of my favorite documentaries-- this was a big disappointment. I realize that not all of the brothers were involved, but I bought it based on the strength of the Malloy "brand." The film seems very unfinished and kind of cobbled together, as if the team ran out of money or interest, and slammed together whatever was left. Particularly disappointing was no real treatment or appreciation for the day to day bike touring (the substitution of the comicaly intended, but cheesy, studio simulations drove my family from the room). Some of the sequences and stories are very good and well filmed, but as a whole, it is weak. Sorry to sound harsh, but for the price, I expected a lot more.
