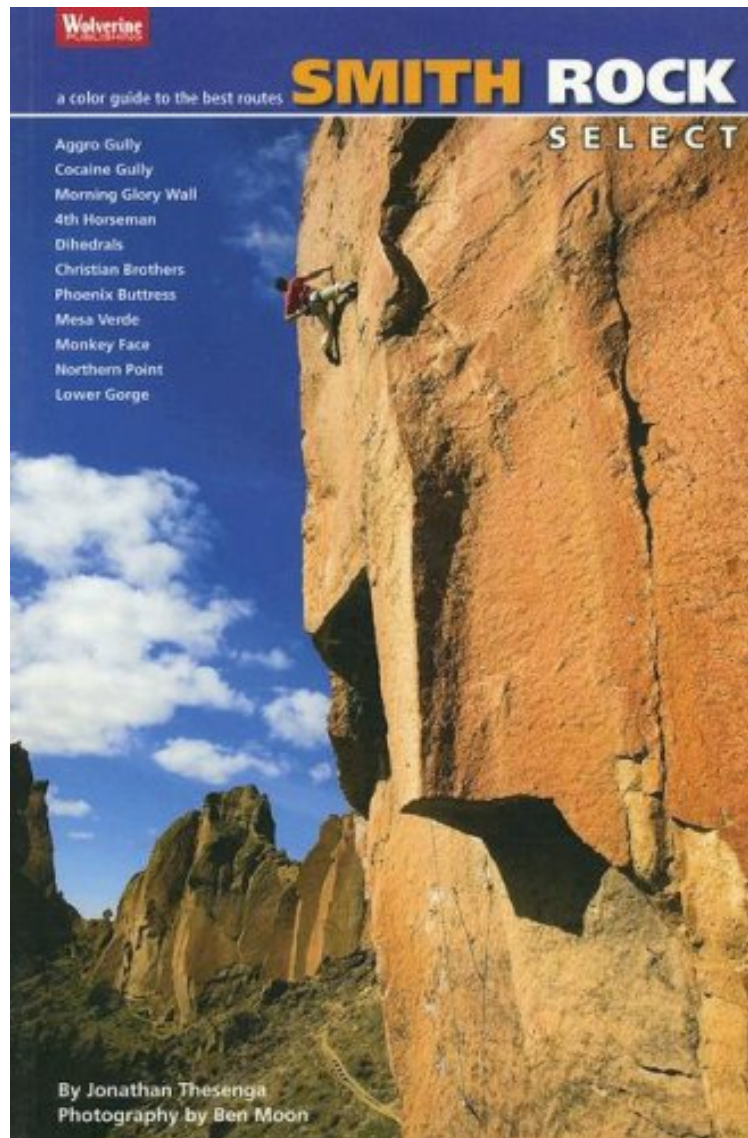

It does not have the same level of detail, does not show the actual bolt placements on the rock, does not show the artist's rendering of the rock face, and the comments usually lack something to be desired. Even so, it is up to date and has lots of color pictures to get you pumped about climbing. I recommend this select book for both beginners and advanced climbers, but most advanced climbers will want the original book to supplement the former's inadequacies.
