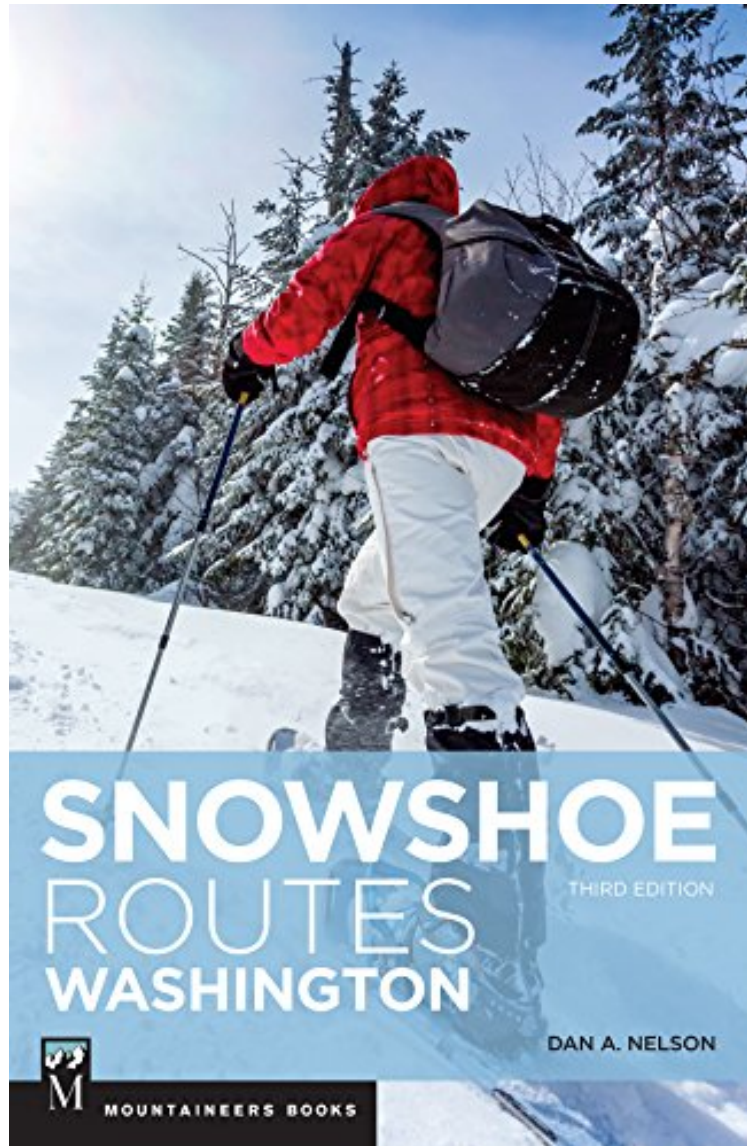

Breezily written with accurate trail descriptions, nice to have for research, and for in-car reference on drives out to the mountains, but the washington trails association website/app and outdoor project apps will have more up-to-date info. The maps are nice, but could be

improved with terrain contour lines. The trails included seem to fall into either "beginner" or "expert" categories, with few in between, and the degree of difficulty ranking seem fairly arbitrary (though of course, that depends on the weather to a large degree).
