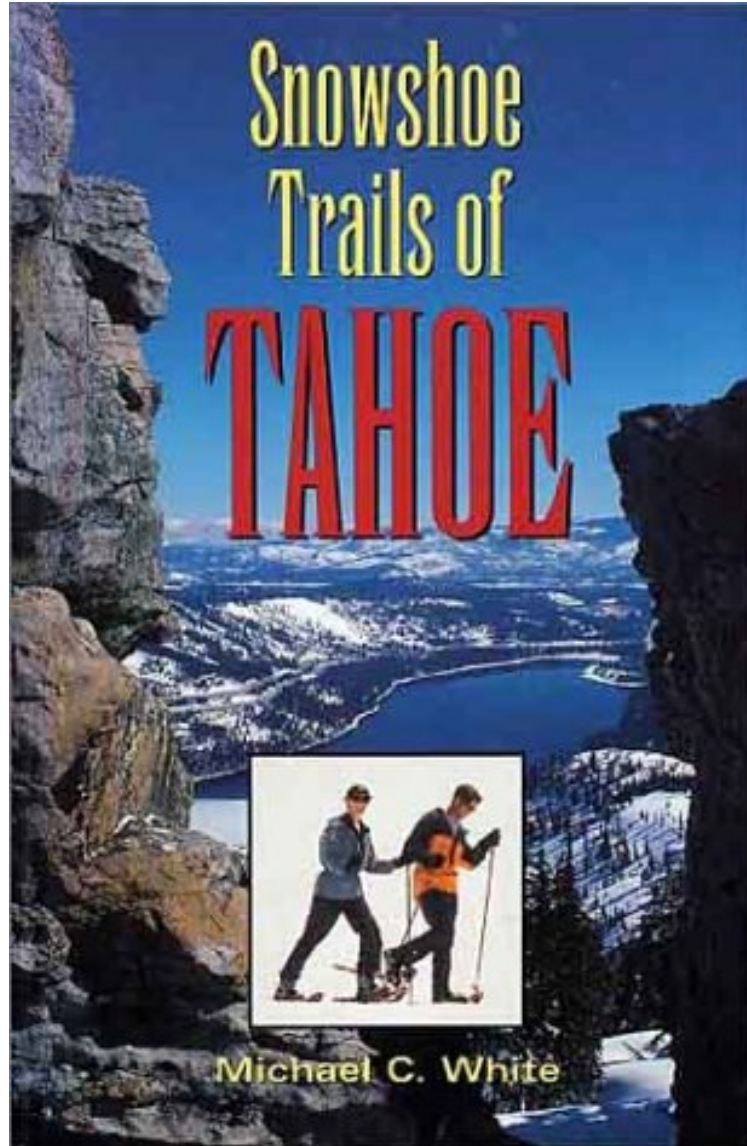

If you want a lot of description about geology and other things, you will not get it at all. I don't mind, because I have other books for that purpose covering the same area. There are also topos for each route in this book.The only things that I dinged a star from is that I thought just a few of the descriptions of

the routes could use a bit more detail and that the eatery information seemed repetitive and maybe unnecessary. I also thought that it was very dangerous to advocate (the picture on the front cover) that people should snowshoe in jeans. Cotton gets wet and dries slowly. It endangers people with hypothermia. The text does advocate synthetic clothing for winter romps in the snow, but I thought the picture should match the text and provide a good example for beginners. 6 of 6 people found the following review helpful.
