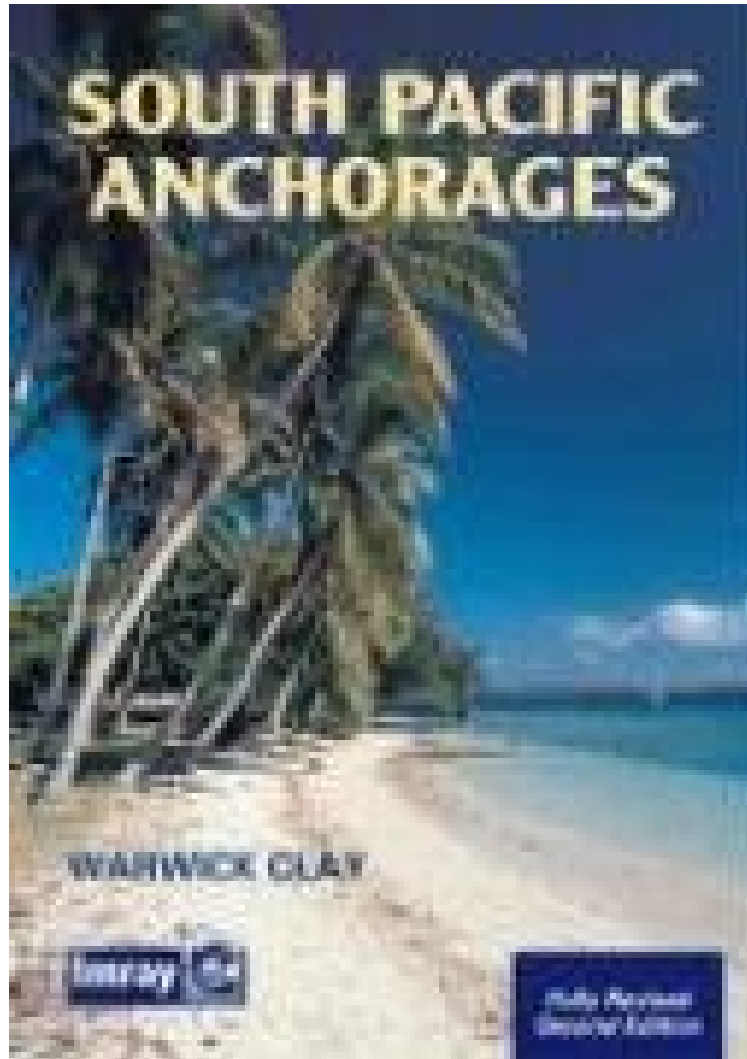

Its 15 years old. and 15 years in the south seas is a very long time as the marine environment especially of atolls, coral, sand bars changes constantly and infrastructure especially on the main islands has improved a lot. 2. at an age of digital photography, the hand drawn sketches appear fairly rough, lacking details. The descriptions are also quite brief and as said outdated. Nevertheless, it is difficult to maintain an up-date, detailed guide for this large region. Its simply not the Caribbean. One has to apply prudent seamanship to explore this region. From this perspective and taken with a grain of salt, this guide delivers valuable information. I wouldn't spend \$30 for it again.
