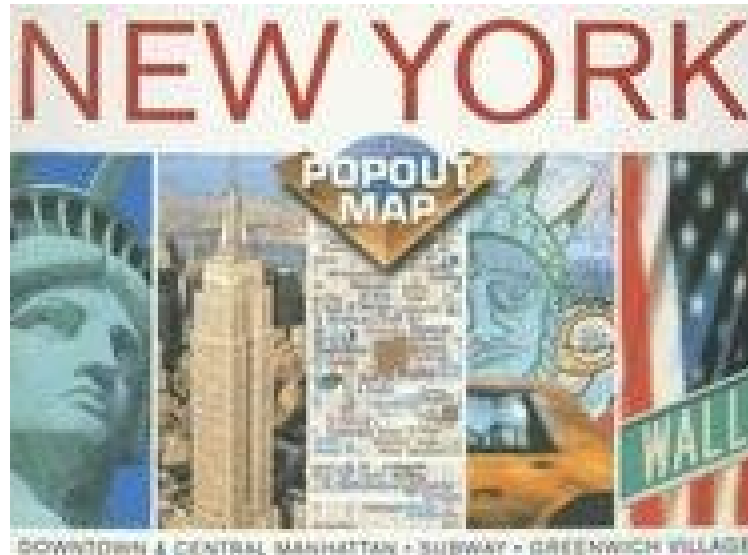

I think it has been sitting on the shelf a while, though, as it shows, along with many other New York attractions, the locations of Borders Bookstores in New York. Um, hello? They all closed in early 2011!! In fact looking at the fine print, it says the map was last updated in 2005. My other complaint has to do with the way the scale is adapted to the city. I have pop-out maps for many cities--London, Paris, Rome, Florence. They have all worked out well for me. But the New York one, not so much. A place or attraction, like Grand Central Terminal, is shown with so large an icon that you cannot see the detail of two of the streets behind the symbol.
