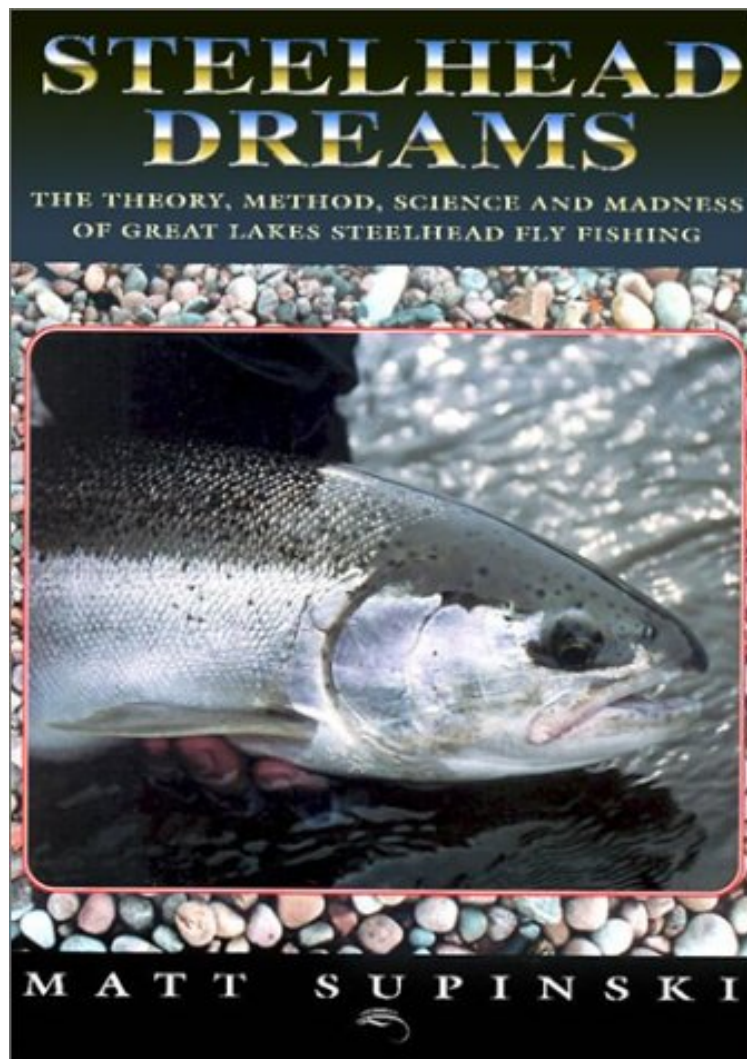

I am an experienced West coast Steelhead and

Salmon angler that has found himself transplanted on other side of the Mississippi. I was looking for a useful guide to the Steelheading opportunities in the Great Lakes region. What I got was a book that I can stand reading for a maximum of 5 minutes at a time. I'm an avid acquirer of fishing books, and all I can say is this: fly-fishing literature is overrun with writers who try to "out-pretty" each other's prose (I once counted the use of the word "elegant" 6 times in one short paragraph). While I appreciate the sentiment and find Steelhead and Steelhead fishing to be a beautiful experience at times, I'd prefer a much more straightforward and economical linguistic approach to a guidebook than that offered by this one.
