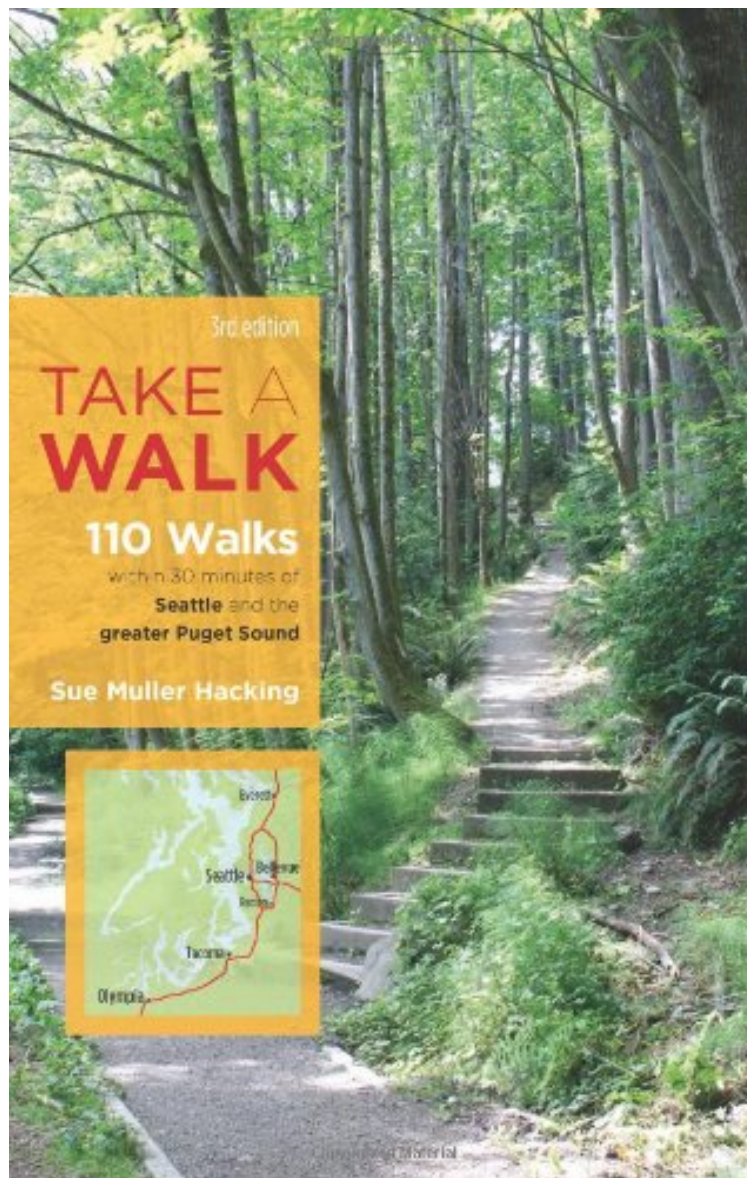


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## Take a Walk, 3rd Edition: 110 Walks Within 30 Minutes of Seattle and the Greater Puget Sound (Take a Walk Seattle)
