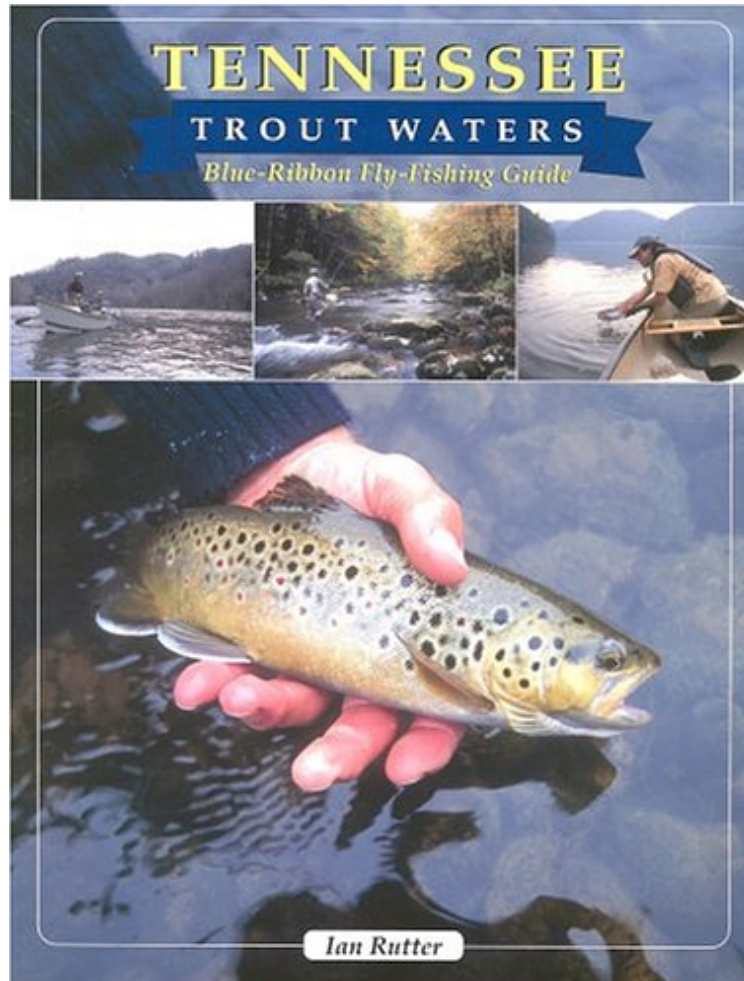

Making the distinction among "tailwater", "lake" and "mountain streams" and the different approaches needed for each is quite helpful. Offering alternatives for tailwater locations is also a big plus. More detail on the streams could certainly be included, but that level of detail can change year over year with a flood event or wild fire. All in all, a good effort and an excellent resource by the author.
