Delightful details for fifteen Texas cities and 29 suggested tours include facilities and places that have changed greatly or no longer exist. Many descriptions and pieces of local information would not be considered "politically correct" today. The book includes over 100 historic black and white photos, illustrations and maps...from ex-slaves, cattle auctions and tortilla factories to oil derricks, airfields and shrines. During the Great Depression of the 1930s thousands of writers were hired by the Works Project Administration to create hundreds of guidebooks on all of the states in the U.S. These volumes that were produced became known as the American Guide Series.
