But her suggestions for, say, the Derby are right on today as they were back in '88.

Each vacation is rated for general ambiance, social climate, and activities. The highest rated in all categories are the Australian Outback, Roatan Island, Yellowstone in winter, skiing in New Zealand, Paris and London via the Orient Express, and Bermuda.
