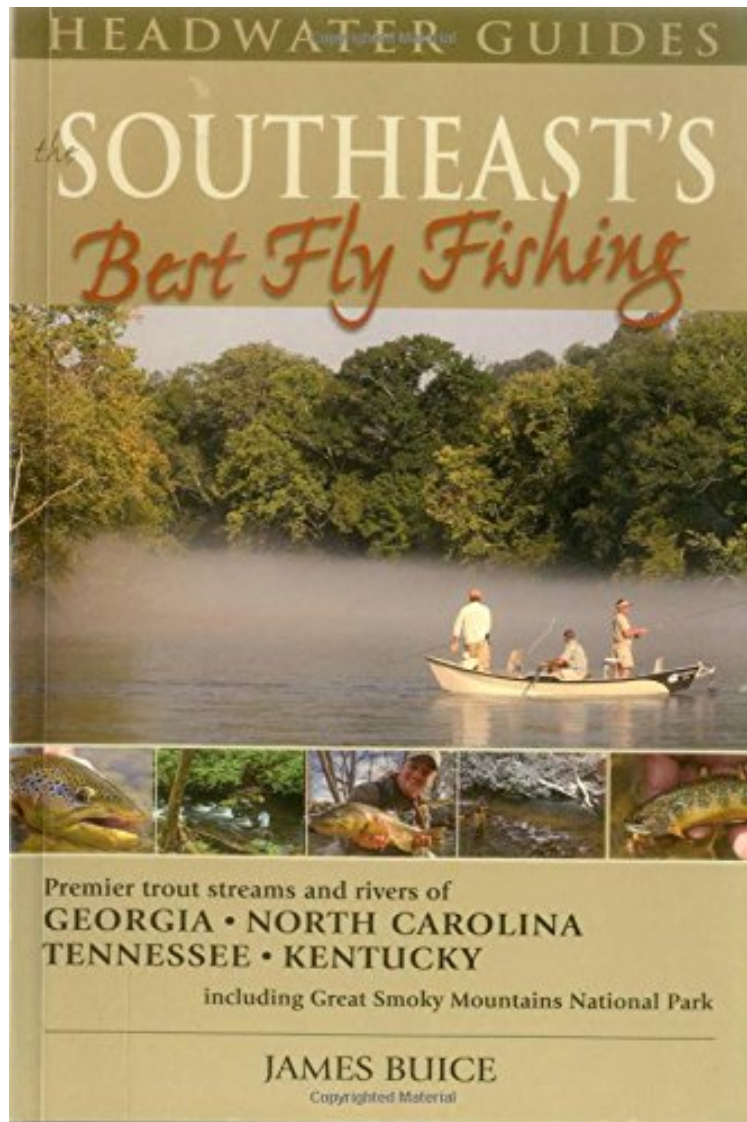

I use this book over and over to map directions, monitor hatch charts, choose flies, and determine new waters to fish. I appreciated the use of color photos in this book--so

much better than black and white drawings so often found in other publications; fly tiers will love it too.
