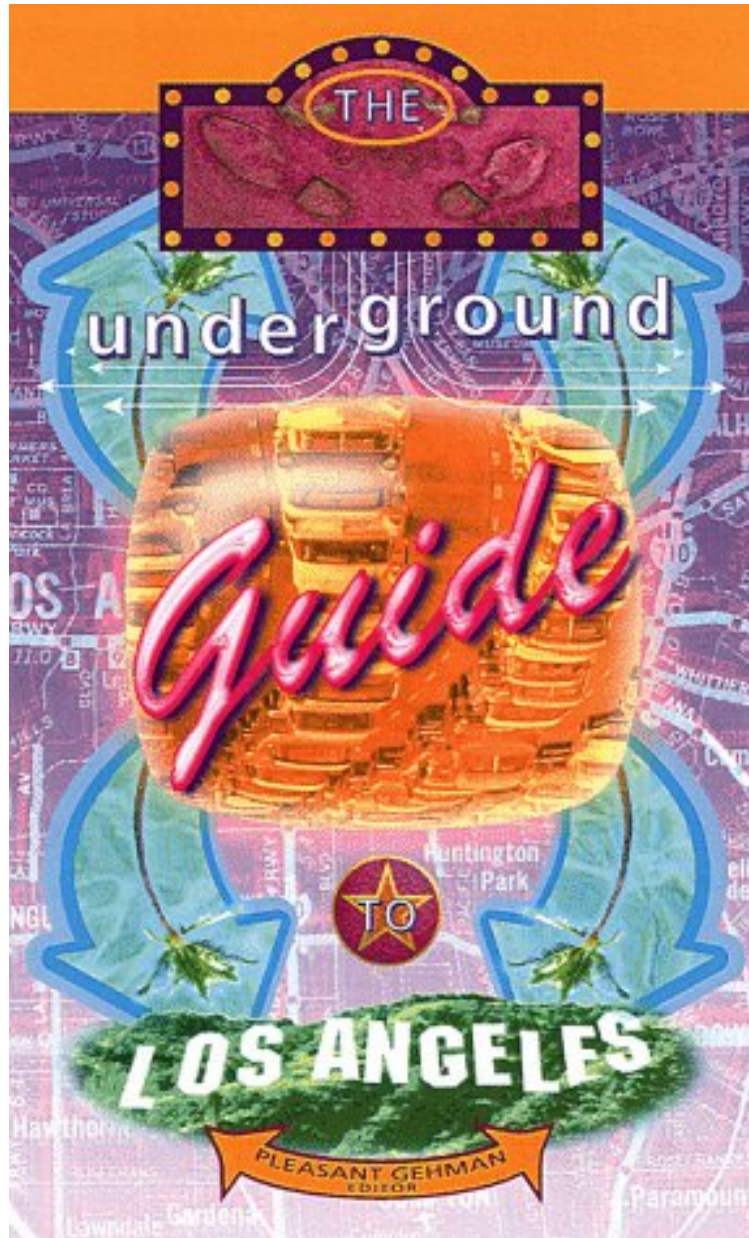

It's more like a series of essays than a comprehensive guidebook, so you can't turn to a specific area or a specific topic, other than the essay titles. It's best as a guide to restaurants, shops, bars, and coffeehouses, but there are much better ones if that's what you are really after. Everything is treated too quickly to really give the reader a good idea what they are getting into. I remember one thing in the Hollywood chapter they pointed out was the Pink Dot, a convenience store that delivers. I "had to" go visit it, thinking it was a famous landmark, but it is really just one of a chain of mediocre convenience stores.
