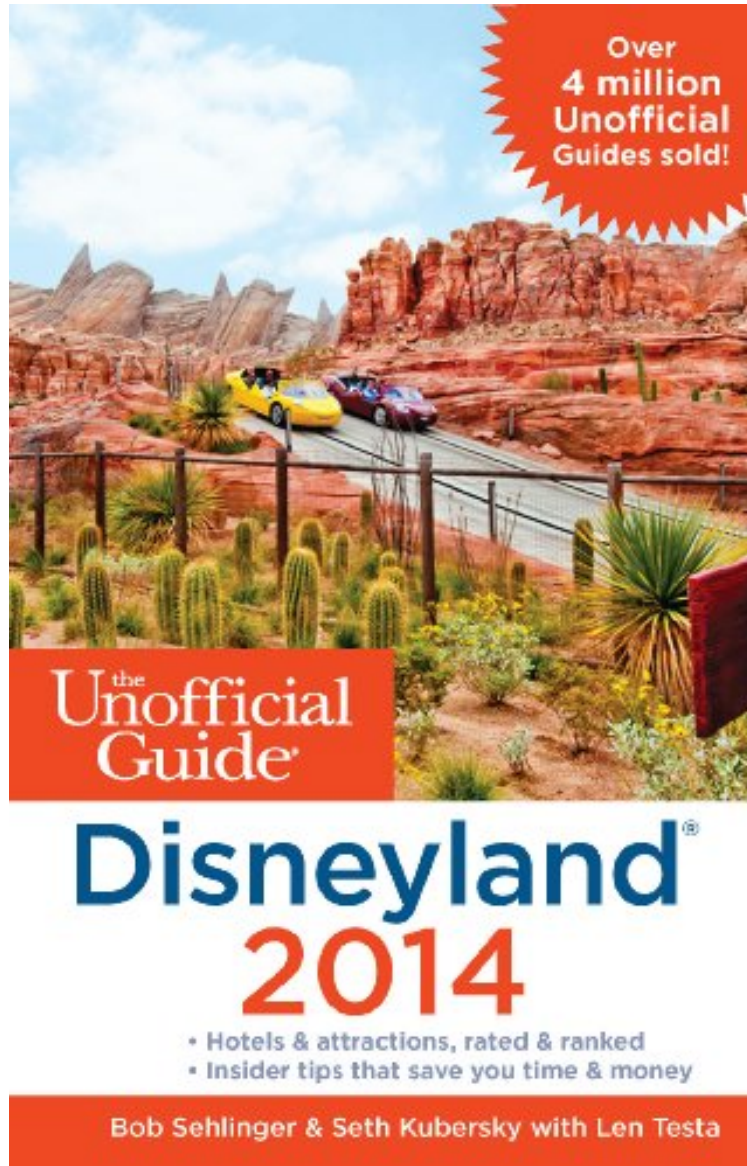

meandering and disjointed. For example, they spend *pages* telling you what they are going to tell you later in the book. The most frustrating part I found was that throughout the book it preaches going back to the hotel for an afternoon nap. But the touring plans don't account for that. They say to "finish the structured part by 3" or "go hard until lunch" which is not only conflicting but vague and not worked into the plans. Overall it's fun to read and get excited for your trip. The tips about what to bring and how to dress and how to prep your family beforehand are outstanding.
