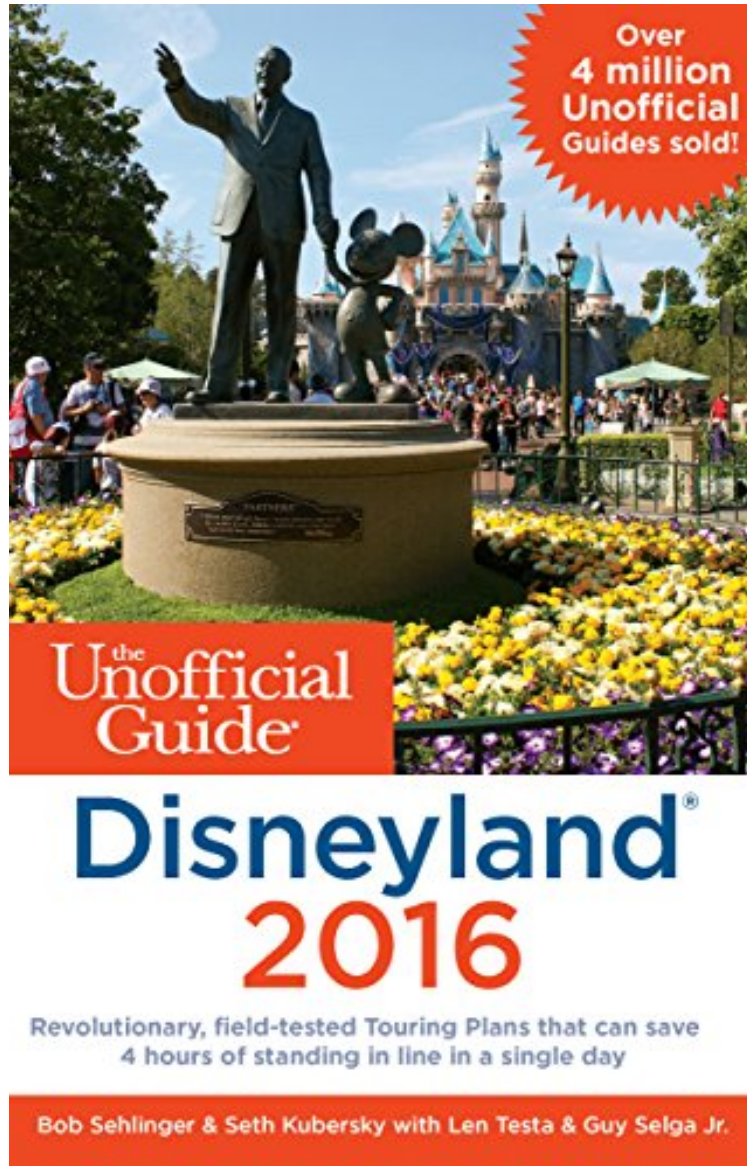

McCleskey It's a good book, but unless your goal at Disneyland is to ride every single ride, don't get insanely focused on following their itineraries to the letter, unless perhaps you are visiting on an extremely busy day. The buildup in the book is such that you'll start to feel like you have to be extremely strict and stick to the itineraries to the letter to have any fun at all, and that's not true at all. That said, the tips in the book are excellent, and we did use quite a lot of them (especially the tip about getting your FastPass tickets to Radiator Springs at California adventure - even though the park was relatively quiet that day, the line for that ride was still insane and in full sun).
