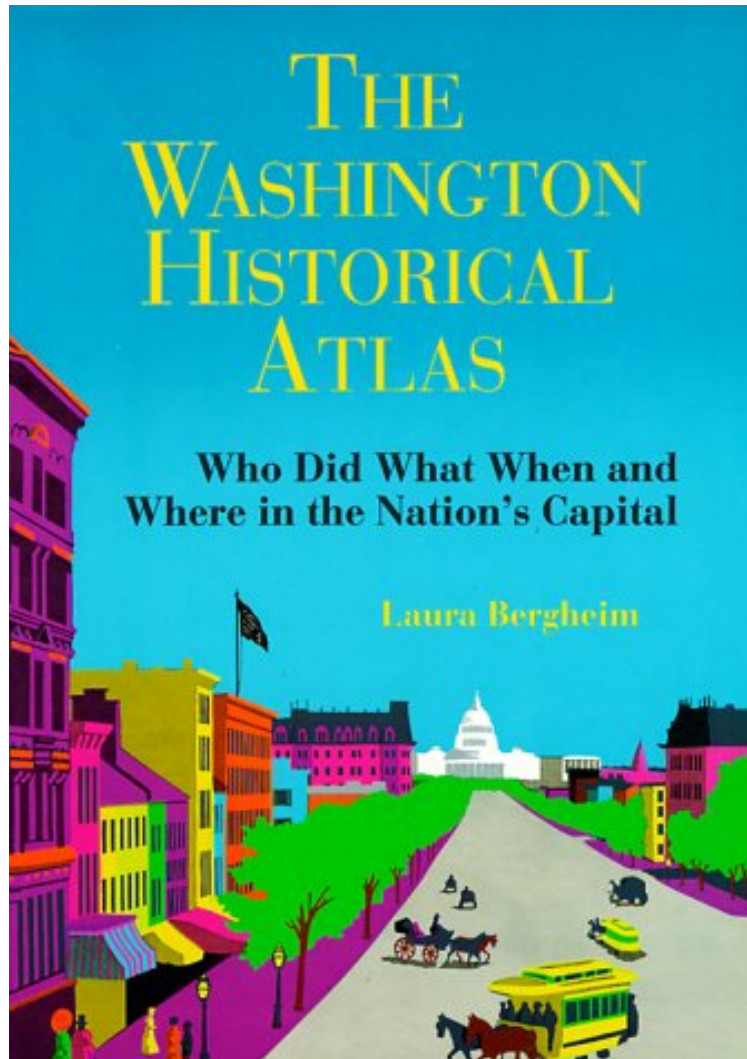

More than a travel guide, yet not a dry historical account, this is a mixture of fact, folklore, a bit of humor, a drop of rumor, and lots of atmosphere. Organized by district, each chapter opens with an overall history and description followed by alphabetical entries, which include extant areas and buildings as well as the sites of noteworthy buildings long gone. Other works on Washington are quoted, and entries are often embellished with excerpts from letters or diaries that bring history to life. While not a portable volume to carry around on excursions, this work is a valuable tool before or after a visit to our nation's capital.
