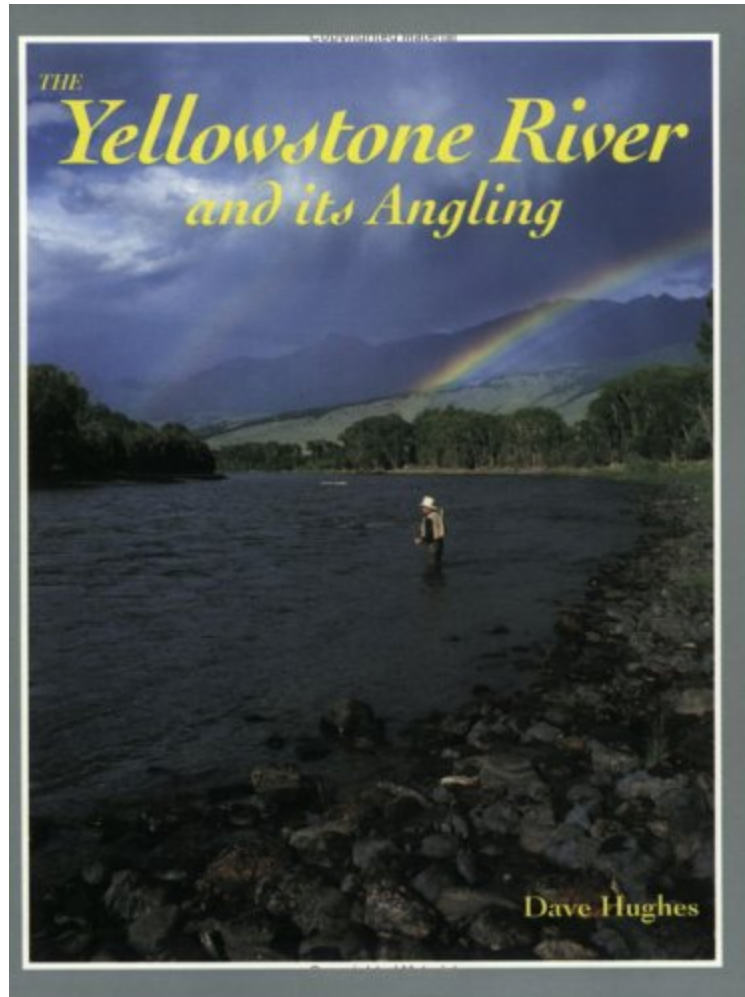

It's well-written and has a lot of great color pictures. It doesn't go into much detail about fishing various spots on the river, but that's offset by the interesting and informative geological descriptions of the river and its origins and the descriptions of some of his adventures on the river. The most intriguing (and a bit scary) adventure was his solo drift from Livingston to Laurel during an early snowfall and severe cold snap in October. This is described in a chapter he aptly titled "The Blue Iceberg.". A must read.2 of 2 people found the following review helpful.
